

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS for Your Transplant Team

1. What medications will be part of my transplant therapy?
2. What do the medications do?
3. How often do I have to take them?
4. Do I have to take the medications at a specific time of day?
5. What specific instructions do I need to follow to take the medications correctly?
6. Are there any foods or beverages I should avoid?
7. Why is it necessary for me to maintain a regular regimen and not miss a dose?
8. What should I do if I miss a dose?
9. What are common side effects of these immunosuppressive medications?
10. What should I do if I am experiencing any of these side effects?
11. What are my different choices of immunosuppressive medications?
12. Where can I learn more about these medications?
13. Will I always need to take immunosuppressive medications?
14. Is there any way that I can get a discount on my medications?

HELPFUL HINTS

- Take your medications according to the instructions of your transplant team or pharmacist.
- If you are unclear about anything your transplant team has told you, ask them to explain it.
- Don't change your medication regimen unless you have your doctor's approval.
- If you experience any signs of infection or rejection, notify your transplant team immediately.
- Talk to your transplant team if you are experiencing any unusual side effects.

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
